



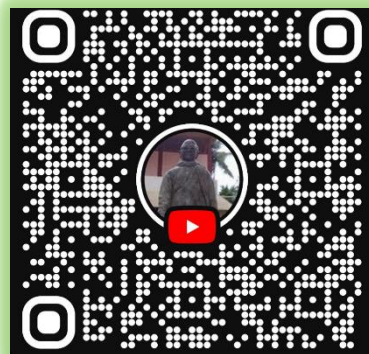

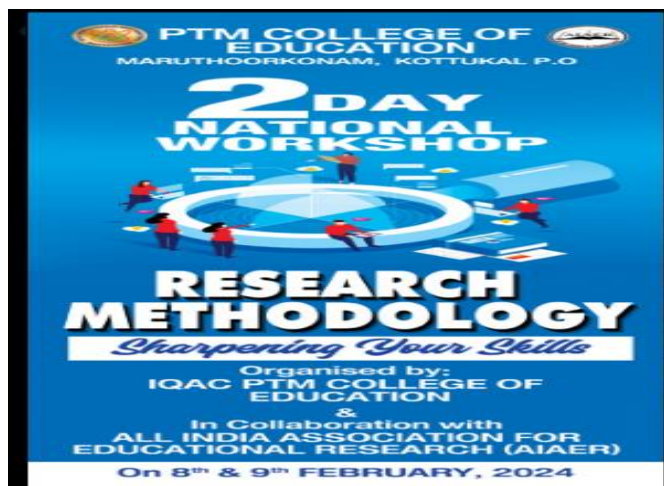
## 5. STEEM 2024 (International Seminar)

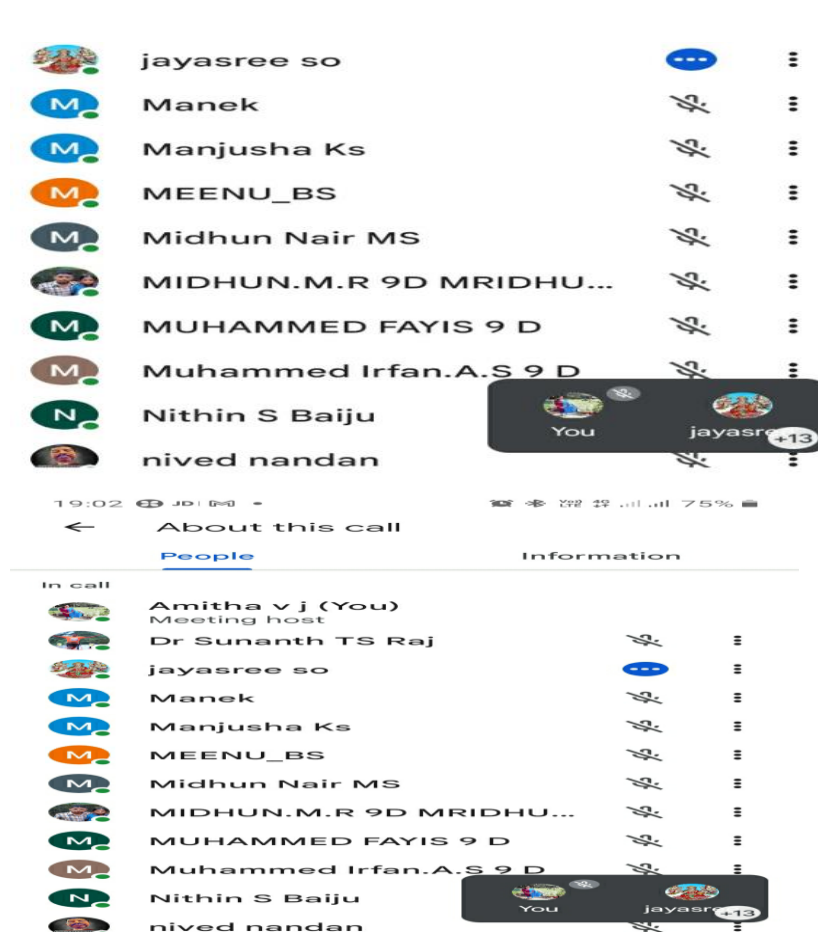
### 3. Awareness on fighting against covid

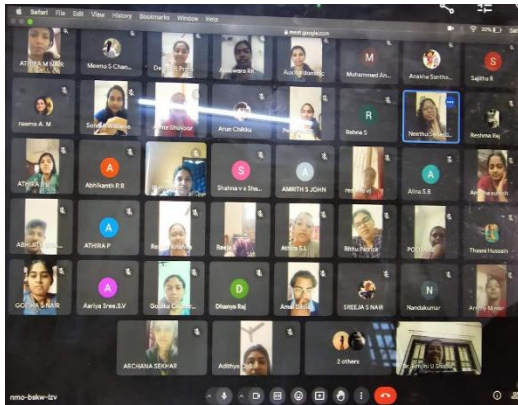
## 3. Fundamentals of Research
